E conclusion	1	The conclusion is not clear and not well substantiated by the data. In effect the findings are overstated.

G formal presentation	2	This is a well structured essay. Tables and graphs are poorly laid out and are sometimes difficult to read. While there is a detailed bibliography there is a lack of detail on the websited accessed.
H holistic judgement	2	There is some evidence of personal engagement and this is supported by the supervisor's comments. Other qualities do not come over strongly.
