A research question	1	The RQ is far too broad and ill defined. Which novels are being compared? Both stories are voluminous. There is a need for supervisor intervention here.
B approach	1	Generally the narrative approach to the topic is inappropriate. The RQ cannot be properly developed without reference to the novels.
C analysis/interpretation	1	There is an attempt at analysis through the 6 aspects mentioned; however, the analysis is superficial and unsubstantiated.
D argument/evaluation	1	The one part on the hero's journey has some potential, but overall the unsupported glance at the chosen features does little to form a coherent argument. The poor RQ does not help.
E conclusion	1	Some attempt is made to answer the question though it is poorly developed. It is hard to answer poorly focused questions
F abstract	1	An RQ, the scope and conclusion are included in the abstract/
G formal presentation	1	TOC broad. No textual references. Footnote form is incomplete. Order and form of the bibliography is poor. All the essential parts are present though not effectively used.
H holistic judgement	1	While the candidate is enthusiastic, there is little evidence that real research or analysis has occurred. The essay is superficial though it does have some structure to it at least.
